Introduction

When the CLARIN-D centres went through the very first CLARIN assessment round (Spring 2013), this was done according to the first version of the CLARIN B centre requirements. When the B centre assessment will be performed again (Spring 2015), new centre requirements will be followed. This document gives an overview of the changes to these requirements that will affect the TLA centre.

We list all of them with an indication whether they affect the second assessment of the TLA:

- **1.a Centre compliancy:** written statement from CLARIN-D technical management about usefulness. Already in place, **no impact**.
- **1.b Policy of offering data and treatment of IPR issues.** Double check if this statement is available online. **Low impact**.
- **1.c Funding support.** There is a statement¹ about future (and funding), although not the most optimal one it covers the period until May 2016. **Impact unclear – depends on interpretation assessment committee.**
- **1.d Visibility of connection to CLARIN ERIC:** logo and link are in place. **No impact**.
- **2.b Privacy statement:** added requirement to comply to CoCo in SAML metadata². TLA is already complying. Implicit recommendation to join eduGAIN (to make CoCo checking easier): already complying. **No impact**.
- **6. Metadata:** added requirement to have MdSelfLink and ResourceProxy elements to resources or Landing Page: already complying. **No impact**.
- **7. Persistent Identifiers:** largely compliant, but no support for content negotiation for HTML/CMDI. Requires some technical changes in the archive. **Moderate to large impact.**
