Mandatory attributes



- In 1.1 attributes are always optional, but some models need mandatory attributes, e.g., TEI header
- A contextual diff is available
 - to extend the component specification with
 - `<Attribute><Required>>true</Required></Attribute>`
 - to express this in the generated XSD as
 - `<xs:attribute ... use="required"/>`

Generic attributes in the CMD namespace



- In 1.1 the attribute names `ref` and `componentId` are reserved as both user defined attributes and CMDI generic attributes are in no namespace
- A contextual diff is available
 - to globally declare the generic attributes in the generated XSD
 - which means that they have to be qualified in the instance
 - `cmd:ref="resourceProxy1"`
`cmd:componentId="clarin.eu:cr1:c_1328259700912"`
